

The following is a report on the disposal of 087-75-0004 and 087-75B0004.

Accession number 087-75-0004, consisting of six cubic feet of United States Secret Service Protective Survey Files, was scheduled for permanent retention under disposition job number NC1-87-76-3. The accession was originally transferred to the Washington National Records Center (WNRC) under disposition authority of NN-463-17 (see Attachment 1).

On August 17, 1993, WNRC's Accession and Disposal Branch (NCWA) received disposition job number N1-87-89-1 (see Attachment 2). N1-87-89-1 changed the retention period of Protective Service Files of a routine nature or those that did not relate to 1) assassination attempts; 2) successful assassinations; and 3) foreign trips for the President and Vice President to three years (see Attachment 3). NCWA applied N1-87-89-1 to the records and changed the retention period of boxes 1 and 6 to three years and "split" 087-75-0004 in the following manner below.

087-75-0004, box 1, disposition authority N1-87-89-1-4B, date of disposal projected as April 1994. The records did not apparently relate to a successful or unsuccessful assassination attempt or pertain to foreign travel.

087-75A0004, boxes 2 through 5, disposition authority N1-87-89-1-4A, transfer to the Office of the National Archives. The records apparently pertained to foreign travel.

087-75B0004, box 6, disposition authority N1-87-89-1-4B, date of disposal projected as April 1994. The records did not apparently relate to a successful or unsuccessful assassination attempt or pertain to foreign travel.

An archives specialist completed making NARS-5 database changes on October 13, 1993 (see Attachment 2).

On December 6, 1993, the NARS-5 Disposal Concurrence Report 23 and Notices of Intent to Destroy Records (NA 13001) were created for the April 1994 disposal cycle. Both accession numbers 087-75-0004 (box 1) and 087-75B0004 (box 6) appear on the Disposal Concurrence Report 23 (see Attachment 4). The appropriate NA 13001's were sent to the United States Secret Service.

On December 14, 1993, during a review of records scheduled for the April 1994 disposal cycle, an archives specialist found that 087-75-0004 (box 1) and 087-75B0004 (box 6) were charged out to the United States Secret Service (see Attachment 5 - notes of the Archives Specialist). Accession number 087-75A0004, boxes 2 through 5, was also charged out to the Secret Service.


Correspondence shows that the Policy Analysis and Records Systems Branch of the Secret Service received and reviewed the NA 13001's related to the April 1994 disposal cycle. NCWA received correspondence, dated February 22, 1994, from the Secret Service that indicated that it wished to reschedule one box of a related accession from temporary to permanent (see Attachment 6). NA 13001's from the same disposal cycle are printed on perforated continuous feed form paper in record group (agency) order. NCWA does not separate each form; instead it separates the forms at the record group break. The Secret Service received its disposal notices as one continuous sheet of paper.

The Secret Service never requested a disposal deferral or otherwise indicated to NCWA that 087-75-0004 (box 1) and 087-75B0004 (box 6) should not be destroyed. In accordance with CENTERS 1300, Chapter 4, if an agency does not notify the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) that a particular disposal action should not take place, the records are destroyed after appropriate internal reviews by NCWA.

On August 3, 1994, a Disposal Approved Report 22 was created for the April 1994 disposal cycle. On August 16, 1994, an

archives specialist reviewed 087-75-0004 (box 1) and 087-75B0004 (box 6) (see Attachment 7). On January 23, 1995, the records were destroyed.

Accession number 087-75A0004 (boxes 2 through 5) was transferred to the Office of the National Archives on June 13, 1995 (see Attachment 8). The Request to Transfer, Approval, and Receipt of Records to the National Archives of the United States (SF 258) was signed by the agency records officer on June 23, 1994 (see Attachment 9).
