Memorandum dated June 30, 2023 and entitled Certification Regarding Disclosure of Information in Certain Records Related to the Assassination of President John F. Kennedy ("June 2023 Memorandum"). See attached Exhibit A, <a href="https://perma.cc/5H8Z-T43K">https://perma.cc/5H8Z-T43K</a>. In the June 2023 Memorandum, the President made his "final certification," which is "the last required under the [John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992]," to "fulfill[] the promise of transparency to the American people" concerning the assassination of President Kennedy. 6/30/23 Memo § 1.

In the Memorandum, President Biden certified under Section 5(g)(2)(D) of the Act that certain redacted information previously certified for temporary postponement of public release in the President's December 2022 Memorandum should be certified for continued postponement. The President determined that "continued postponement of public disclosure of that information is necessary to protect against identifiable harms to the military defense, intelligence operations, law enforcement, and the conduct of foreign relations that are of such gravity that they outweigh the public interest in disclosure." Id. § 3. The President directed that any records not subject to his certification be released to the public by no later than June 30, 2023. *Id.* § 4.

The President also directed that future releases of the postponed records "occur in a manner consistent with the Transparency Plans," id. § 3, previously prepared by agencies that include "event-based or circumstance-based conditions that will trigger the public disclosure," id. § 5. The President determined that use of "[t]he Transparency Plans will ensure that the public will have access to the maximum amount of information while continuing to protect against identifiable harms to the military defense, intelligence operations, law enforcement, and the conduct of foreign relations under the standards of the Act." *Id.* § 5.
